
CQ WW 2023 - Statistics for SSB and CW

- 9638 logs received SSB
- Y/Y + 7%
- 1500 showing up just one hour after the contest ended!
- 4,656,180 QSOs made during the contest (a 13.2% increase from 2022), producing an amazing average
- 27 QSOs in every second of the contest.

- 28 QSOs in every second of the contest.




CQ WW 2023 – Statistics Log RTTY

CQ WW RTTY Contest (1987 - 2023)





Do Your Logging During the Contest!


- “Correction of logged call signs and exchanges **after the contest**, by use of any database, recordings, email or other methods, is not allowed.”
- “Contacts should be logged at the time they are completed.”

Top Competitor Rules

- “Stations competing for World and Continent awards must provide **actual frequencies** for all contacts in the log.”
- “Any single operator entrant (see V.A.1) competing for a top three finish at the (a) World, (b) Continent, or (c) USA levels, **must record the transmitted and received audio as heard by the operator** for the duration of the contest operation...”

SDR Sites

- Wide band recordings of all bands
- Many sites around the world
- Enables us to go back and hear what actually happened during the contest – provides proof!
- Helps with investigating rule violations
 - Band changes in MS/M2
 - More than one signal
 - Bad or wide signals



Fair Play

- Contesting uniquely depends upon the integrity of the contestants
 - No referee, inspectors, spectators in the shack
- Single operators work alone
 - If you use the DX Cluster, or RBN, or other help, you are in the Assisted category
- Stay within category power limit
